Quest - Divine Meal

DIALOGUE - Moreguns & Mary Nara

CAPTAIN MARY NARA: Captain Moreguns? I need your help! Carbonarians and Bolognesians are fighting all over the Boiling Frontiers!

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): Again? Give 'em some pasta and booze, and they'll be singing space shanties in an hour.

CAPTAIN MARY NARA: You misunderstand, Captain. They have raised their cannons and started firing at each other.

CAPTAIN MARY NARA: With the undead Holy Lance fleet threatening the galaxy again, we can't afford infighting.

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): Any idea what their beef is about?

CAPTAIN MARY NARA: They can't make up their minds about what the Flying Spaghetti Monster is made of - Carbonara or Bolognese.

CAPTAIN MARY NARA: If you could just settle it. Pick a side if you need to. Anything to help them come to terms.

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): I'll do what I can.

CAPTAIN MARY NARA: Thank you, Captain. May His Noodliness protect your hulls with sauce and soften your collisions.

OBJECTIVES - Resolve the Conflict between Bolognesians and Carbonarians

ACTION - Player returns to Mary Nara before completing her objectives

DIALOGUE - Moreguns & Mary Nara

CAPTAIN MARY NARA: Have you solved their dispute yet, Captain? I can still hear cannon fire, and those are not the "Pastival" fireworks.

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): Ave. I'm on it.

ACTION - Player speaks to Bolognesians

Player sails to the Boiling Frontiers and comes across two ships exchanging cannon fire - the Bolognesian and the Carbonarian. They speak to Thermokon, the Bolognesian Captain

DIALOGUE - Moreguns & Thermokon

CAPTAIN THERMOKON: Visitors identified. Pirates. Captain Moreguns. State you intentions.

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): I've come on behalf of Captain Mary Nara to bring an end to your hostilities with the Carbonarians.

CAPTAIN THERMOKON: Impossible. Carbonarians contradict knowledge database entry: Flying Spaghetti Monster composition: "Bolognese." Unacceptable.

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): The Pastafarian Gospel teaches us to accept pasta of all shapes and sizes, doesn't it?

CAPTAIN THERMOKON: Pastafarian Gospel is outdated. New directives apply. Flying Spaghetti Monster composition: "Bolognese." Heretics and blasphemers must be exterminated.

ACTION - Player speaks to Carbonarians

Player sails to the Boiling Frontiers and comes across two ships exchanging cannon fire - the Bolognesian and the Carbonarian. They speak to Carb O'Nara, the Carbonarian Captain

DIALOGUE - Moreguns & Carb O'Nara

CAPTAIN CARB O'NARA: Greetings, weary spacefarers! Have you come to join our prayer to His Noodliness?

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): No, I've come to put an end to your pointless infighting... by order of Captain Mara Nara, I might add.

CAPTAIN CARB O'NARA: Not until these filthy Bolognesians renounce their heresy and accept the truth - His Noodliness is made of Carbonara, not Bolognese.

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): Err... does that really matter? Shouldn't we "love pasta of all shapes and sizes," as the Gospel teaches?

CAPTAIN CARB O'NARA: Choose your words carefully, Captain Moreguns. You are in no position to quote the Gospel to my face!

CAPTAIN CARB O'NARA: If you truly wish to stop the bloodshed, make Captain Thermokon of the Bolognesians renounce his blasphemous claims.

IF - The player spoke to both sides and isn't hostile to neither of them

DIALOGUE - Moreguns & Sam

FIRST MATE SAM: Captain? I don't think we should be taking sides in their conflict. There has to be a peaceful solution.

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): Have ye seen them, mate? Do they sound like they want peace?

FIRST MATE SAM: They might, if we bring in someone well-versed in the Pastafarian Gospel. Someone like... Rabbi Yolly!

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): What? Are ye seriously gonna take advice from this looney?

FIRST MATE SAM: Looney or not, Pastafarians do listen to him. Why not give it a try?

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): Alright. I'll think about it.

OBJECTIVES (Optional) - Find a Peaceful Solution to the Conflict

QUEST BRANCH - Carbonarians

ACTION - Player returns to Thermokon before completing his objectives

DIALOGUE - Moreguns & Thermokon

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): Listen up, ye rusty bucket! The Flying Spaghetti Monster is made of Carbonara - and that's it!

CAPTAIN THERMOKON: Blasphemy! Heresy! Exterminate!

OBJECTIVES - Defeat Bolognesians in battle

ACTION - Player defeats Bolognesians in battle

DIALOGUE - Moreguns & Thermokon

CAPTAIN THERMOKON: Requesting surrender. New directive applied. Flying Spaghetti Monster composition: "Carbonara."

CAPTAIN CARB O'NARA: Very well. I accept your surrender.

CAPTAIN CARB O'NARA: Behold, my fellow Pastafarians! His Holy Noodliness has guided the ignorant to the truth. Let us now welcome the new Carbonarians into our ranks!

Bolognesians and Carbonarians stop fighting

OBJECTIVES - Return to Captain Mary Nara

ACTION - Player returns to Mary Nara

DIALOGUE - Moreguns & Mary Nara

CAPTAIN MARY NARA: So the dispute is settled. How long will this fragile peace last? Time will tell.

CAPTAIN MARY NARA: But for now, thank you, Captain. Here is your reward. May your plates always be full of pasta. Ra'men!

ENDING 1

REWARDS: Moderate **ACHIEVEMENTS**: None

QUEST BRANCH - Bolognesians

ACTION - Player returns to Carb O'Nara before completing her objectives

DIALOGUE - Moreguns & Carb O'Nara

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): I wanna make it clear, lady! The Flying Spaghetti

Monster is made of Bolognese. Deal with it!

CAPTAIN CARB O'NARA: As you wish, Captain. Your heresy will have

consequences.

CAPTAIN CARB O'NARA: Cannoneers, fire at will!

OBJECTIVES - Defeat Carbonarians in battle

ACTION - Player defeats Carbonarians in battle

DIALOGUE - Moreguns & Thermokon

CAPTAIN CARB O'NARA: Stop it! Cease fire! I renounce my claims! I accept that His

Noodliness is made of Bolognese! Please, have mercy!

CAPTAIN THERMOKON: Surrender request status: Accepted.

Carbonarians beliefs updated: Flying Spaghetti Monster composition: "Bolognese."

Bolognesians and Carbonarians stop fighting

OBJECTIVES - Return to Captain Mary Nara

ACTION - Player returns to Mary Nara

DIALOGUE - Moreguns & Mary Nara

CAPTAIN MARY NARA: So the dispute is settled. How long will this fragile peace last? Time will tell.

CAPTAIN MARY NARA: But for now, thank you, Captain. Here is your reward. May your plates always be full of pasta. Ra'men!

ENDING 2

REWARDS: Moderate **ACHIEVEMENTS:** None

QUEST BRANCH - Peaceful Solution

ACTION - Player speaks to Rabbi Yolly

The player sails to Pasta Faria II, a large orbit station surrounded by a protective wall of giant space noodles.. They dock at the Pastafarian Shrine and spot Rabbi Yolly enjoying a pasta meal next to an altar

DIALOGUE - Moreguns & Rabbi Yolly

RABBI YOLLY: Greetings, spacefarers! You must be so hungry! Come, have some Penne of Replenishment. Or, perhaps, it is wisdom you seek? Try the Dumplings of Enlightenment!

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): Not this time. Bolognesians and Carbonarians are at each other's throats, arguing over what kind of pasta the Flying Spaghetti Monster is made of.

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): I need your help to make them come to terms.

RABBI YOLLY: The Gospel clearly states that His Noodliness is made of every type of pasta that exists, has ceased to exist, and is yet to spring into existence.

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): That is a valuable noodle of wisdom, no doubt. The problem is, they don't exactly follow the Gospel.

RABBI YOLLY: It saddens me to hear that. Perhaps a Divine Meal, consisting of every pasta dish in existence, might restore their faith.

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): Can you cook this Divine Meal?

RABBI YOLLY: A Divine meal requires a Divine inspiration. And that, in turn, requires a sacrifice. Bring me a Virgin Tomato to my altar, and I shall cook the meal for you. CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): Well, that's not a big deal. Sam, give him a virgin tomato from the kitchen!

RABBI YOLLY: No, I need THE Virgin Tomato. The one blessed by His Noodliness! RABBI YOLLY: There is only one of a kind in the entire galaxy. And right now, it is in unworthy hands.

RABBI YOLLY: Speak to Kira Noodlesbane of the Antipasters. But be warned, she will not part with the Virgin Tomato with ease.

OBJECTIVES - Visit the Anstipasters in their hideout

ACTION - Player returns to Rabbi Yolly before completing his objectives

DIALOGUE - Moreguns & Rabbi Yolly

RABBI YOLLY: Merciful meatballs, you have returned! Have you brought the Virgin Tomato by chance? Or are you here for the Dumplings of Enlightenment? CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): I'll leave you to your prayers.

ACTION - Player speaks to Kira Noodlesbane

Player sails deep into a dense asteroid field in Rigatoni Rim and comes across a well-defended pirate space station with the Antipasters flag on its roof.

DIALOGUE - Moreguns & Kira

KIRA NOODLESBANE: Well, well, if it isn't Captain Moreguns! What brings you here, you old rag?

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): Rabbi Yolly told me you have the Virgin Tomato. I need it to end the bloodshed between the Bolognesians and Carbonarians.

KIRA NOODLESBANE: And why should it concern me?

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): The undead Holy Lance fleet is wreaking havoc across the galaxy. Don't you think it's time for the Pastafarians to stand united against a common enemy?

KIRA NOODLESBANE: Hmm... no.

But if you want the Virgin Tomato so badly, you can have it... for a price.

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): What?! You want me to pay for a bloody tomato? KIRA NOODLESBANE: It's not just any "bloody tomato", and you know it. After all, you came all the way here for it.

KIRA NOODLESBANE: This is the price. Take it or leave it.

DIALOGUE CHOICE 1 - Attempt to take the Virgin Tomato by force DIALOGUE CHOICE 2 - Pay for the Virgin Tomato

QUEST BRANCH - Attempt to take the Virgin Tomato by force

DIALOGUE - Moreguns & Kira

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): Well, Kira. You leave me no choice...

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): Raise the cannons!

KIRA NOODLESBANE: You have never been smart, Captain Moreguns. Oh well...

OBJECTIVES - Defeat the Antipasters

ACTION - The player defeats the Antipasters forces and plunders their shipyards

ITEM GAINED: Ordinary Tomato

DIALOGUE - Moreguns & Sam

FIRST MATE SAM: This tomato doesn't match Rabbi Yolly's description, but it does look similar...

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): I like your way of thinking...

OBJECTIVES - Return to Rabbi Yolly

ACTION - The player returns to Rabbi Yolly with the Ordinary Tomato in their cargo

DIALOGUE - Rabbi Yolly

RABBI YOLLY: Merciful meatballs, you have returned! Have you brought the Virgin Tomato by chance?

DIALOGUE CHOICE 1 - Tell the truth

DIALOGUE CHOICE 2 - Let Sam do the talking

DIALOGUE CHOICE 3 - Lie about the tomato

IF - Tell the truth:

DIALOGUE - Moreguns & Rabbi Yolly

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): We... err... crushed it. But we've brought another smooth, good-looking tomato.

RABBI YOLLY: This isn't the Virgin Tomato, I'm afraid. His Noodliness will not accept it as a sacrifice, nor will He bestow His divine inspiration upon me.

RABBI YOLLY: Therefore, I shall not be able to assist you.

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): So, this is it? Are ye gonna let Carbonarians and Bolognesians kill each other?

RABBI YOLLY: They have stepped onto the path of violence. I can only hope His Noodly Appendage shows mercy upon their rotten souls.

RABBI YOLLY: For now, do what you must to resolve their conflict. May His trail of sauce guide your sails and your souls.

IF - Let Sam do the talking:

DIALOGUE - Sam & Rabbi Yolly

FIRST MATE SAM: This tomato doesn't match Rabbi Yolly's description, but it does look similar...

RABBI YOLLY: Most intriguing! By His Noodly Appendage, do tell! FIRST MATE SAM: Well, there was a bit of a mess. And there were many... tomato casualties. But this little fella survived against all odds. I'd say this is not a coincidence.

RABBI YOLLY: You didn't go in cannons blazing, did you? One does not stop violence among Pastafarians by stirring violence among Pastafarians!

FIRST MATE SAM: Oh, not at all! They just had a little... accident... in the kitchen.

FIRST MATE SAM: The point is, if this little tomato survived when all the others did not, it must be a miracle! What if it's blessed by the Flying Spaghetti Monster?

RABBI YOLLY: You speak words of wisdom, young man. Perhaps we should give it a try.

RABBI YOLLY: Go ahead, then! Place the tomato on the altar.

OBJECTIVES - Place the Tomato on the Altar

ACTION - The player interacts with the Altar

ITEM LOST: Ordinary Tomato

QUEST BRANCH - Buy Tomato

DIALOGUE - Moreguns & Kira

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): Errr... have it your way. Here is your gold. KIRA NOODLESBANE: A wise choice, Captain. Pleasure doing business with you.

ITEM GAINED: Virgin Tomato

OBJECTIVES - Return to Rabbi Yolly

ACTION - The player returns to Rabbi Yolly with the Virgin Tomato in their cargo

DIALOGUE - Moreguns & Rabbi Yolly

RABBI YOLLY: Merciful meatballs, you have returned! Have you brought the Virgin Tomato by chance?

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): There you go.

RABBI YOLLY: Fascinating! I can feel the purity of His Noodly Appendage emanating from its red peel.

RABBI YOLLY: Go ahead! Place the tomato on the altar.

OBJECTIVES - Place the Tomato on the Altar

ITEM LOST: Virgin Tomato

(Back to) QUEST BRANCH - Peaceful Solution

DIALOGUE - Rabbi Yolly

RABBI YOLLY: Yes! I can feel it - the Divine inspiration!

RABBI YOLLY: It's as if the knowledge of all the cooks before me gathers like a storm at the edge of my awareness!

RABBI YOLLY: And with this knowledge, I shall cook the meal of all meals - the Divine Meal!

RABBI YOLLY: In the name of the Pasta, and of the Sauce, and of the Holy Meatballs, Ra'men!

ITEM GAINED: Divine Meal x2

OBJECTIVES - Resolve the Conflict between Bolognesians and Carbonarians

ACTION - The player returns to Bolognesians

DIALOGUE - Moreguns & Thermokon

CAPTAIN THERMOKON: Visitors identified. Captain Moreguns. Requesting status update: Carbonarian beliefs to be changed to "Flying Spaghetti Monster" made of Bolognese.

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): Negative. But I've got something to challenge your beliefs. Here, give it a try.

CAPTAIN THERMOKON: Analyzing. Object identified: Divine Meal. Consumption: safe. Trying. Contents identified: all meals in existence. Quality: divine.

CAPTAIN THERMOKON: Protocols initiated. Knowledge database updated. Flying Spaghetti Monster composition: remove "Bolognese", add "All types of pasta in existence."

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): Are you going to stop fighting fellow Pastafarians now?

CAPTAIN THERMOKON: Commencing priotity changes. Ceasefire imminent. "Peace and Unity" protocols initiated.

ITEM LOST: Divine Meal x1

ACTION - The player returns to Carbonarians

DIALOGUE - Moreguns & Carb O'Nara

CAPTAIN CARB O'NARA: Do you bring good news, Captain Moreguns? Did the Bolognesians accept that the Flying Spaghetti Monster is made of Carbonara?

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): I've brought something better. Here, give it a try. CAPTAIN CARB O'NARA: Is this... the meal of all meals? The Divine Meal?

Mmmm... It is so... divine!

CAPTAIN CARB O'NARA: I see it now. His Noodliness is not made of Carbonara or Bolognese. He is made of all types of pasta that have ever existed. We are all His blessed noodles!

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): Great... Does that mean you can stop fighting now?

CAPTAIN CARB O'NARA: Yes! I was wrong. We were all wrong. I shall call for a ceasefire at once!

CAPTAIN CARB O'NARA: Thank you for opening my eyes, Captain. May His noodles wrap around your soul!

ITEM LOST: Divine Meal x1

IF - The player gave Divine Meals to both sides

DIALOGUE - Sam

FIRST MATE SAM: Captain! It's working! They stopped fighting! We should report to Mary Nara.

OBJECTIVES - Return to Captain Mary Nara

ACTION - The player returns to Mary Nara

DIALOGUE - Moreguns & Mary Nara

CAPTAIN MARY NARA: Captain Moreguns! What you did for our community was remarkable. The Carbonarians and Bolognesians won't stop celebrating and singing space shanties!

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): Ye're welcome, I suppose.

CAPTAIN MARY NARA: Is there any noodle of wisdom you wish to share, so we can cook more of those Divine Meals?

CAPTAIN MOREGUNS (PLAYER): Err... store your tomatoes in a safe place.

CAPTAIN MARY NARA: That is... invaluable. Thank you, Captain, on behalf of the Pastafarian community.

CAPTAIN MARY NARA: Here is your reward. May pasta be upon you.

REWARDS: High

ACHIEVEMENTS: Peacemaker
