Solaria Lore - Ideas

Idea 1

Before the creation of Solaria, the Makers and the Voidspawn wage a war. The makers lose. Their leader Sol creates Solaria with mortal races, hoping that when mortals develop as a species and reach their final step of evolution, they will "ascend" and become the new generation of Makers. But mortals fail to meet his expectations, so Sol decides to destroy the world and create anew. So the players need to fight both the Voidspawn who seek to corrupt Solaria, and the creator of the world.

Idea 2

The Eternals create a new world full of beautiful landscapes and populate it with life. Their creation becomes a blooming paradise, where all living beings live in harmony. Since the idea was proposed by Sol, the Eternal of Light, and he tore a part of his essence to create the sun, everyone agreed to name the new world "Solaria". But one of the Eternals, Thanatos, argued that light doesn't warrant Sol the credit, because light isn't essential. To prove it, he created the Voidspawn, creatures of darkness that consumed light, killing all life around them. Terrified of his actions, the other Eternals imprisoned Thanatos in a realm of darkness. Since then, Thanatos creates tears in the veil between realms and sends his Voidspawn to terrorize Solarians. He seeks to eliminate all light in Solaria and create a world of eternal darkness

Idea 3

Sol, the God of Light, got bored on his throne and started creating things. His first creations were obedient ethereal beings who would act on his whim. At first, it seemed entertaining, but eventually Sol got bored. It was too predictable. He wanted his creations to act on their own, to surprise him. So he created more species. This time, Sol gave them corporeal bodies and made them mortal. They would have their strength, weaknesses, and desires. They were unpredictable, which Sol liked.

But his first ethereal creations got jealous and attempted to destroy the corporeal creatures. Sol admired them for finally surprising him. So instead of destroying his firstborn, he exiled them to another realm. To make things more interesting, Sol allowed them to create tears in the veil, so that they would occasionally invade the mortal world. And the mortals would defend themselves. Finally, some action!
